### THE CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESSES

### **Dear Cooperative Friends,**

I am pleased to present in brief of accounts of the accounting year 2020-2021 certified by the auditor & with the consent of all committee members, reports, union's works & activities in the 70th annual general body meeting of Sumul Dairy.

Accounting year was began with global pandemic resulting in 66 days lockdown situation was arisen in the whole country in which all enterprises were got stopped or partially were in operation, in short, all businesses and involved employees working were lost their operations and jobs.

In that difficult period, due to all the facilities developed by the union itself resulting in we faced minimal hindrances in our business.

Due to established facilities by the union itself like milk societies in villages, BCUs, milk transportation, tankers arrangement, our cattle feed factory, veterinary doctors, employees for societies supervision, our chilling centers, dairy plant, processing units, arrangement of sale of products, under the milk is an essential service, resulting in we specially done successfully.

By the self established systems, we could able to supply milk and milk products to the our customers in the city easily and disposal of milk of the village milk producers and other essential goods were made available without interruption. Worldwide and across the country has taken note of ours these successful activities.

To stop the global pandemic, awareness regarding this, application of information successfully implemented through field staff and magazines continuously at milk society level by the union.

The 5 liter sanitizer jar was provided, free of cost to each society by the union first time and second time, keeping in view of members, the sanitizer free of cost was provided to control the infection by doing necessary planning.

In the month of March and April, the cash facility was made available for milk payment at milk society level so that farmers could not go out from home to bank or ATM to withdraw cash.

To members of milk societies, all the goods like ghee, oil, tea, cattle feed, seeds, chemicals etc. were made available supply uninterrupted.

Union has been taken care of those who are not pouring milk in societies but milk was accepted from such types of farmers and set an example of cooperation.

All the needs of societies were made available at door step through electronic media such as telephone, Whatsapp without interruption.

Animal treatment services were made available continuously as a milk cooperative activity and did not seen negative effect of lockdown, ours this type of activity, in the coming days, by the collective efforts will pave the way for effective development.

### 1. UNION MEMBERSHIP:

Number of Primary Milk Producers' Co-operative Societies affiliated with the Union is 936, at the end of financial year.



### 2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

The period of the committee of 16 Talukas of the union has completed on 11/07/2020, to fill all these posts, it has been informed to the District Registrar, Surat. After that, according to cooperative societies act, all these post filled by doing election process by the Nayab Collector and City Prant. And the Chairman and Vice Chairman was elected by the committee members and taken charge of the management.

### 3. BUSINESS & FINANCIAL POSITION:

The total turnover of the union is Rs.4,139 Crores (with sales, auxiliary income & stock) which is 2.31% means 94 Crores more than the previous year. Total sales of the union were recorded Rupees 3,583 crores which is 2.40% means rupees 88 crores less than the previous year. After deduction of depreciation of Rupees 7,724 lakh, union has achieved the profit of Rs. 9,47,10,238 net profit at the end of the year 2020–2021

Board of Directors has recommended to distribute 15% Dividend, within the limit of provision in Co-operative act.

### **4. AUDIT:**

Audit procedures of milk producing societies and the Union are governed by the audit board under continuous and concurrent audit scheme.

### 5. MILK PROCUREMENT: :

During the financial year, the animal husbandry business at village level was remain operational continuously during corona infection, resulting in, the priority increased of this type of business at village level and by the union, various direct and indirect programs were conducted towards productivity enhancement of the animals resulting in, the total 62,14,38,613.10 kilo milk was procured during the financial year which is 15.23% more observed, Union was given aid of Rs.154.12 crores to qualified societies under various schemes during financial year (Rs. 66.19 crores more paid to those societies having BCU for BCU fat difference)

During the year, union has paid Rs. 772.67 per kg fat to milk producers, which is 2.17% more paid in comparison of last year and, the union achieved net profit of Rs. 9,47,10,238, which is 4.66% more in comparison of last year.

We are pleased to inform the all dairy farmers that unfavorable situation arisen during the Covid pandemic in that in condition during the year, union could able to paid more Rs. 16.43 and Rs. 31.00 per kg fat of average fat rate of buffalo and cow milk, respectively. And union could able to paid to BCUs fat difference at the rate of Rs. 24.93 per kg fat which is Rs. 4.33 per kg fat more than last year.

During the lockdown and corona pandemic, more than 22 lakh people were migrated, resulting in, the effect of migration had been seen on Surat market.

As compare to last year we could sell more 97,44,363 ltrs milk, means 2.01 % more milk sold. And growth in sale of paneer, shrikhand and sweet was increased also.

During the year we could make sell maximum milk per day was 14,01,703 litres & maximum butter milk per day was 2,99,766 liters. During the year 9,76,661 liters milk & 1,84,513 liters butter milk on an average been sold per day in Surat city, Tapi District & rural areas.

During the year, Sumul Dairy sold 21,017 kg dahi, 10,915 liters ghee, 4,947 kg paneer, 1,416 kg sweet and 1,005 kg shrikhand on an average per day.

### **6.1 SUMUL BAKERY:**

During the year, total quantity 2507.69 MT of bakery products was sold and business of 20.54 crores in terms of money done. The 143.98% increased sale was noticed in compare to last year.

### **6.2 ICE CREAM PLANT:**

During the year, total quantity 40,13,587.76 litres of icecream was sold and business of 45.17 crores in terms of money done, means 5.40% increased sale was noticed in compare to last year. In which, total quantity 1,63,308 litres of icecream was sold as a distributor and along with other products of Amul, the business of 5.07 crores in terms of money done.

### 6.3 Sumul Food Factory – Take Home Ration (Chalthan):

To eradicate malnutrition through supplying nutritive food, this plant installed by collective efforts of Sumul-Amul and Integrated Child Development Scheme (GOG), under that, THR products were sold of Rs. 314.30 crores by the union during the year.



### 7. Development programmes of Milk societies & Milk production:

### 7.1 AUTOMATIC MILK COLLECTION STATIONS:

With the aim of procuring fresh and clean milk at the society level along with enhancing self-assurance while getting slip showing Milk Fat, SNF, quantity and price of milk supplied by member during milk collection, Automatic Milk Collection Stations are installed at milk societies. A software package for entire accounting procedure of the society having modern facility has been incorporated therein. An arrangement has been made that society member pouring milk will get his details on computer at the end of month. During the year 881 milk analyzers on 634 societies were installed to get analyze milk fat and SNF.

To get the details of receiving of the societies having BCU, 1052 societies have been made online by which all the details of receiving could be received over here & Milk collection data are being stored over here. So, whenever problem arises in this regard, details could be received from here.

At society level milk procurement is being done by "Automatic Milk collection station". AMUL AMCS software application is being planned for the implementation of uniform milk procurement fashion at all the societies. If phone number has been registered by AMUL AMCS software in the computer, he will be get provided details of the milk procurement daily. In addition by AMUL AMCS application installed in android phone of member by which member will get the details of his milk procurement on his mobile whenever he wants.

### 7.2 (A) BULK CHILLING UNIT:

To maintain & control the desirable standards of the production, to maintain the quality in the procurement & the processing of the milk & Sumul is the best example in this regard. To make milk and milk products as per international standards, milk having high quality need to be procured right from the village level; so Union has commenced "Bulk Chilling Units" having different capacities to facilitate chilling of milk at society level and could be transported by tankers to the union, and chilling of milk at the place of production which has helped to improve quality of milk; and milk of two or four times can be brought by single trip as per suitability of time, and also society can collect milk at their desired time and preserve milk by chilling. Immediate cooling of the milk leads to stop the growth of the micro organism. So, dairy gets about 97.30% of milk having MBRT of 5–6 hours due to which we could be able to supply high quality milk in the market.

### 7.2 (B) ISO 9001: 2015 CERTIFICATION OF SOCIETIES:

To improve in milk quality & to improve administration, 262 societies have received ISO:9001:2008 certificate of international standards up to the year 2015-2016 & in the year 2016 – 2017 ISO: 9001: 2008 version was upgraded to ISO: 9001: 2015. 429 societies were having such international standards certificate in the year 2019-2020. During the year 2020-2021, more 14 societies were audited got received ISO: 9001: 2015 certificates by Global Sustainability Certification and Inspection Service (GSCI).

As of now 443 societies are having ISO: 9001: 2015 certifications. The validity of the certification will be up to 2024. This was possible due to the positive cooperation of Chairmen, Vice Chairmen, secretaries, Committee members & members of the societies. At present we have following societies talukawise having ISO: 9001: 2015 certificates of International Standards.

### 7.2 (C) CLEAN MILK PRODUCTION:

Milk is one food commodity and there can be adverse effect on its quality if proper care is not taken during production, procurement and transit. Milk is a raw material, and from it milk, and milk products like Ghee, Powder, Butter, Paneer, Curd, Buttermilk, sweets etc are being manufactured. Quality of all products depends on process and raw material. If raw material has good quality, then finished product will have better quality.

Strategy like cleanliness of milching animals, healthy animal, cattle care and personal



hygiene of milking person, cleanliness of milking place and cattle-shed, cleanliness of milking vessel and utensils of milk collection at the society, and, responsibility lies with producers for speedy and time bound follow-ups of all activities right from the point of milk production by milching animals. Whereas responsibility of cleanliness of milk collection point, cleanliness of milk utensils, cleanliness of BCU centre and maintain timely and careful transit of milk to the Union/chilling centre lies with directors of the society. The processing of milk at the Union becomes speedy and easy due to good quality milk, thus quality milk and milk products can be supplied to customers.

As milk is the best food for us likewise it is also best food for micro organisms. They multiply very fast in the milk & spoil the milk quality within a short period. Contamination & growth of microorganism in milk can be controlled by getting knowledge by members regarding Clean Milk Production.

To encourage clean milk production Sumul had started incentive scheme from month of July 07 for milk coming from BCUs depending on bacterial load found in the milk. To encourage/improve more quality of the milk depends on number of bacterial load 0-5 lakh or less, 20 paise per litre being giving as incentive.

### 8.1 TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME AT MILK SOCIETIES:

Every year, the Tree Plantation Campaign is being organized by the union as a social responsibility. Beside of the corona infection, carefully, by the forest nurseries and ours cooperation 954791 common saplings in which 88337 fruit tree saplings with aid were provided and total 10,43,128 samplings of tree planted by the union.

### **8.2 MILK HOUSE AID SCHEME:**

Milk house is the center of conduction and development of the milk society, for that, union is providing a special aid facility to made available milk house. Those societies are not having their own milk house, in this regard, union providing financial aid of Rs. 3,50,000/- and extra Rs. 1,50,000/- to those who committed to install BCU. During the financial year, total Rs. 1.44 crore given 49 milk societies as an aid. Specially, under the milk house/godown scheme of government aid, Rs. 30 lakh to 6 milk societies made available.

### 8.3 WOMEN SAVING GROUPS SCHEME (Managed by Sumul Research & Development Scheme):

At village level, women start to savings from her income and this savings can be utilized towards family members education, health, social and entrepreneurial works and increase her encourage and mental strength of self sufficient women in true meaning, the women saving group is in working.

During financial year, 4715 women saving groups and 71752 women from 893 milk societies covered and total Rs. 97445283 made withdraw during the year. And total saving of Rs. 192096416 made during the year. Provision made of an attractive interest facility. To make more successful, this work is being done by women resource person by collecting savings of women members.

### 8.4 ACCOUNTING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME OF MILK SOCIETY:

Day to day, the economic analysis and conclusion of all daily accounting activities of milk society are being done by secretary/employee; it is an important activity. The secretary of the society is as important as life saving oxygen and the accounting in recording is very important for development of society and recording of accounts of society is being done by them, for that as a campaign, union has provided theoretical and practical training to 582 secretaries of milk societies for one week along with awareness regarding various products, informatics literature were provided. From April 2021, every society must be record their accounts itself those who have get recording by other agency, for this planning has been done for make mandatory to record the data in computer under AMCS program in computer available at society level.

Due to which having high genetic profile, the male calves are being produced & out of these 366 male calves had been selected at the national level. "Sabarmati Ashram Gaushala, governed by NDDB is preparing Semen Doses and is being used at national level. This is the great achievement of our union.



### 9.4 PURE BREEDING PROGRAMME (PBP):

With the help of GCMMF, Anand, 27 milk societies got involved by our union under PBP. Under this programme, by doing measurement of milk those animals having capacity to produce more milk, the offspring of such animals inseminate by the semen dose received from premium cow bull/buffalo bull to produce heifers in more numbers with high genetic profile with the aim to get more milk production.

# 9.9 SCHEME FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF DAIRY FARM OF 12 MILCHING ANIMALS FOR SELFEMPLOYMENT THROUGH ANIMAL REARING BUSINESS:

To encourage animal rearing as a business, at village level to create opportunities for self employment and to discourage urbanization, for that, by the Government of Gujarat, started giving aid through this scheme in 2018-19 to establish dairy farm of 12 milching animals. There were three compulsory components of that scheme viz., construction of cattle shade (600 sqr. Feet), purchasing of 12 milching animals and insurance premium. In which, Rs.1.50 lakh subsidy against 3.0 lakh investment for cattle shade construction, 8.5% loan interest subsidy for 5 years in loan taken and Rs. 43,200 subsidy in insurance premium payment, provisions were applicable. Additionally, in optional components, the subsidy will be given of Rs. 18,000 for chaff cutter, Rs. 33,750 for milking machine and Rs. 9,000 for fogger system purchasing. However, per unit in first year subsidy of approximately Rs. 3,06,350 to be given to schedule cast and women beneficiaries. Under this scheme, 30 units to be installed in Surat district and Tapi district. So far, following work done under the scheme in the year 2020-21.



On the completion of satisfactory audit, after one month, in December 2020 BIS Type-2 license (no. 7200199713) awarded by BIS. This is an evidence of good quality and now onwards, we can print ISI logo and license number on bags, however, regarding quality, Sumul Dan Factory Bajipura get awarded BIS Type-2 license first among the member unions of Gujarat and other Dairies. This is a thing of proud of Surat District Cooperative Milk producers' Union ltd., Surat.

To print date and time of production as per BIS requirement on HDPE & jute bags, a machine has been installed and made available in finished product godown at Sumul Dan Factory Bajipura. Also, the printing matter on bags has been changed as per BIS requirement and on every bag, details of use of Sumul Dan and information regarding nutrients elaborated.



Sumul Dan Factory, Bajipura, to satisfy necessary requirement, producing quality cattle feed by using combination of scientific modernization and latest technologies, all available raw materials and various resources, continual inspection and improvement in related process and procedures is committed to supply balanced cattle feed continually at minimum cost.

During the year 2020-21, the feed requirement of Banas Dairy, Palanpur and Vasudhara Dairy, Valsad is decreased, hence sale of Sumul Dan is also decreased in comparison of year 2019-20.

# 9.11 SUPPLIMENTARY CATTLE FEED (Sumineral forte plus, Ferticare gold, Sumul Milk Shakti powder, Sumul calcium pellets, Sumul Dewormer Dan):

Mineral Mixture is a mixture of various major mineral & trace elements viz. calcium, phosphorous, iron, zinc, magnesium etc. remarkable difference in mineral contents of soil in hilly terrain, tribal belt and coastal area is noted. Mineral content in soil has its effect on fodder and lastly on health of animals. In order to maintain good health of animals, the supplementation of mineral mixture in the feed is necessary. To avoid mineral deficiency in animal body, keeping this in mind, mineral mixture powder plant at cattle feed plant Bajipura have been made operational. So that, we have able to manufacture and supply of good quality chelated mineral mixture to milk producers' through co-operatives societies.

To eliminate fertility problems in animals due to mineral deficiency, "Sumul Ferticare gold Plus" powder enriched with bypass fat & chelated minerals is being produced by sumul dairy & being arranged to sell at society level. Sumul Sumineral forte Plus, Sumul Ferticare Gold, Sumul Milk Shakti powder are being sold from the Bajipura as per following.

### 9.14 SUMUL CATTLE GROUP INSURANCE & PUBLIC PERSONAL ACCIDENT POLICY:

Livelihood of the member gets vanished when priceless animal-herd dies either due to disease or by any other means. In order to run livelihood, insurance of animals taking scheme is continued by the union. Under this scheme, 5,465 animals were covered through 1,457 policies. The Rs. 2.74 crore as premium was paid to insurance company. Getting upon approval of 753 animals insurance claims, amount of Rs. 3.94 crore have been paid to members.

### 9.15 SUMUL ANIMAL BREEDING CENTRE AT VANSKUI:

Under Calf Rearing Programme till now 2,286 heifers has been distributed from this centre whereas 11 heifers grown and distributed during the year. Three bulls having High Genetic Merit were sold to Panchamrut Dairy, Godhra for the purpose of production of semen doses. The rearing of 1 cross bred heifer and 15 Gir heifers, total 16 heifers are being rear under scientifically strategic calf rearing programme with help of GCMMF, Anand, from this, cross

bred heifer achieved 310kg body weight at the rate of 720gram/day growth in 14 months got pregnant and first calving will be at the age of 24 months as per target decided under strategic calf rearing programme. And at present, 15 Gir heifers are being rear at the center with growth rate at the rate of 620gram/day.

During the year total 1,550 bags vermi compost fertilizer, 191 kilogram earth worms, 26,843 litre gir cow urine, 6,033 kilogram vermi compost residue and 8486 kilogram dung was distributed. Additionally, improved hybrid varieties of fodder stem cuttings such like 31350 nos. of bullet grass, 600 nos. of hybrid Napier Coimbatore-4 and 312 kg Jinjva grass with high protein was distributed to the various society members under union's catchment. During the year, different organizations and societies 1825 visitors had visited and taken direction and guidance regarding scientific animal husbandry.

### 9.16 SUMUL SAKHI DAIRY FARM - BHANAWADI:

Women of "Women Saving Groups" managed by union, avail employment at her door step by adopting animal husbandry business, to bring financial progress, in March 2020 a community dairy farm "Sumul Sakhi Dairy Farm" at Bhanawadi, Ta: Vyara, Distt. Tapi was started.

Every month, experts from our union, fulfill the farm consultancy during their perceptible visit to their farms to accelerate profitable animal husbandry business. Mastitis is mainly observed in milch animals especially in high yielding animals. Generally, if our milk producer could be able to diagnose the mastitis before its clinically appearance then it can be prevented calving loss of animal, milk of particular lactation and huge financial loss of the milk producer, that's why our union has implemented such important programme with the help of GCMMF, Anand.

In this programme, milk producers himself diagnose the subclinical mastitis then it can be planned to prevent it immediately. Before the symptoms appear, diagnosis of this disease made in more than 50% animals out of covered in this programme and we could be able to prevent loss to the animal and their financial loss.

### 9.24 MASS DEWORMING CAMPAGIN:

The more number of diseases are being seen in the animals caused by internal parasites (worms) in the rainy season. The decreased milk production, slow body development, weakness, loose motion, indigestion and infertility related problems are being seen due to internal parasitic diseases. To eradicate these diseases, the deworming tablets/bolus were distributed under mass deworming campaign. The 25% subsidy is being given by the union.

### 10 QUALITY CONTROL, QUALITY ASSURANCE & ISO SYSTEM:

To do chemical analysis of milk, the union has made available advanced equipments in the main dairy laboratory and in the all laboratories of centers like Lahe Plant, Icecream Plant, Goa Plant, Jesingpura, THR Plant and Bakery unit made well equipped. Total 2, FT-1, FFT-2, six Milkoscan (FT120), six Indiscreen machines and two Marsh Milkoscan machine and NIR are functioning at main dairy lab and which are capable to give accurate information regarding adulteration. To count bacterial load in milk, the latest hitech Bactoscan machine is in function at main dairy laboratory. At Sumul Dairy for A1 & A2 protein examination, modern RTPCR machines are there.

The GCFID machines at main dairy laboratory, Lahe and Goa Plant have been installed to analyze milk fat quality.

At the main dairy laboratory as well as at all chilling centre laboratories and at Lahe plant B. R. digital machine was given which is useful to check the quality of the milk fat.

In the union's Navi Pardi unit, bakery & ice cream product and powder plant laboratories made well equipped with all means for the testing of the products quality as per FSSAI norms. To test Take Home Ration (THR) products quality, the well equipped laboratory made available at THR Plant, Chalthan.



### **SUMUL MOBILE LABORATORY:**

First time in India, Sumul Dairy has started "TESTING ON WHEELS" a mobile laboratory from August 2017 for customers of Surat city to test milk & its products free of cost. And second mobile laboratory started from November 2017 which is analyzing milk samples of society members at society. An intension to start mobile lab is to aware/get inform customers that whether they consuming milk & its products are of as per standard or not. In this mobile laboratory fat, SNF or any other adulteration is being tested. It is made well equipped with modern equipments to test milk & its products. It can be tested any other adulteration made in ghee and for that BR machines are being installed. Detection of harmful adulterants in bakery products are being analyses too by the mobile lab. The mobile lab will be available at which place, a time schedule is being advertised in various news paper for that.

For the customers of Surat city a customer care department has been established. In which customer care operator clarify that deviation or any defect of milk sample tested by customer based on mobile lab data.

Customer is being informed if result is not as per the standards.

Under the new food safety act, if it is found any chemical or biological defect in the samples taken by them may lead to spoil the reputation of Sumul, may get punishment & humiliation. To avoid such we all are in try constantly to be aware at every stage from rural milk collection to customer, in every field & bound to food safety & quality by our team work.

By following ISO system we could make remarkable improvement in the quality of milk from rural area. During the year there is an improvement observed in the temperature of raw milk, acidity and in MBR.

### 10 (A) Quality Management System: (ISO: 9001: 2015)

To match with as international standards regarding food safety, in fact our union had been achieved ISO: 9002:1994 certificate by applying Quality Management System in the year 2000 only. Quality Management System made latest by getting ISO Standard upgraded as per 9001: 2000 in the year 2000, Sumul Dairy Surat and Lahe Plant (Nashik) together was certified as per ISO:9001:2008 in 2008.

To maintain quality, it is necessary to be remaining alert for cattle care, milk society, Bulk Chilling Units, Chilling Centres, Milk transportation, mediating dairy units of the dairy during all these activities, the precaution and care to be taken and it is necessary that milk of good quality to be available to the customers be careful, also. In October 2013, our Navi Pardi Centre also been certified with ISO: 9001:2008 certificate. At present from January 2017, all chilling centers been certified with new standard ISO: 9001:2015.

We could have done improvement in the quality of the milk step by step. At rural level 6 societies had received ISO 9001:2000 certificates in 2005. Also, that had been revaluated in 2008, and got renewed certificates up to 2011. In April 2010, more 26 societies have received ISO: 9001:2008 certificates and at another 49 milk societies, in April 2011 survey was conducted by the "Sai–Global, Australia" & all these 49 societies were got awarded ISO: 9001:2008 certificates. In the year 2013–14, more 50 societies were certified with ISO



9001:2008 under quality management system. Total 355 Societies were certified with ISO 9001:2008. All the BCUs have been certified with new standard ISO: 9001: 2015 from March 2017, at present. In the year 2018-19, more 50 societies were awarded ISO: 9001: 2015 certificates under quality management system, now there are total 449 milk societies got awarded ISO: 9001: 2015 certificates.

Sumul Dan Factory, Bajipura, got awarded ISO: 9001:2015 certificate by implementing Quality Management System, also.

Sumul Bakery & Icecream plant at Navipardi also awarded ISO: 9001:2015 certificates by implementing Quality Management System, also.







### 10 (B) Food Safety Management System: (ISO 22000: 2018) And FSSC:

In the year 2000, by obtaining Codex (HACCP 9000) certificate we became prepared with this design to maintain International Food Safety norms

In 2006, Food Safety Act as similar to ISO Standard 22000, by implementing such certificate was received in November, 2008. Also, in March 2014, all the four Chilling Centers being certified with ISO: 22000:2005 food safety management. As per Food Safety Act and standard 2006, our responsibility will be up to "Grass to Glass". To assure that milk doesn't contain any harmful elements to health, Sumul dairy, Surat & Lahe plant (Nasik), both together being certified with ISO: 22000:2005 in the year.

Sumul Dairy Surat, Sumul Dairy Navi Pardi (Bakery, Powder Plant & Icecream Plant) also got awarded ISO: 22000:2018 certificates by implementing Food Safety Management System.

Sumul Dairy, Surat and Navi Pardi have been certified with FSSC 22000 international standards for export from 2019.

### 10 (C) Environment Management Systems: (ISO 14001:2015):

Our organization is aware regarding environment and committed to control pollution and protect environment. Since 2002, our organization certified with Environment Management System means ISO 14001:1996 has done modernization of the Environment Management System as per ISO 14001:2004 in May, 2096, further got renewed till 2014. In March 2014, as per ISO:14001:2004 re-evaluated and updated, at present, as per ISO:14001:2015 re-evaluated and got updated.

We have achieved notable targets regarding environment in every field. Natural sources like electricity & water were being used judiciously. We have obtained National Energy Conservation award 7 times for saving electricity & energy. In tree plantation aspects, 354 saplings of small and large trees plantation has been done. And, in the align with this 10,43,128 total nos. of tree plantations done by union at village level societies of Surat & Tapi district, in that global achievement union was contributed their role as a eco-friendly partner, by which this will brought enhancement in the climatic wealth, certainly. To make available good environment to the next generation, toward this the cooperation and involvement of all the friends is required.

### 10 (D) Management System (ISO) Training:

External training for internal auditors of food safety & quality management system is being given to 20 employees from plant, engineering, laboratory, marketing, purchase & HR regarding ISO 22000:2018 standards through DNVGL and 20 employees were given training of internal auditors regarding new standards ISO:9000:2015 and ISO:9001:2015 by DNVGL. 43 officers from Sumul Dairy were appointed as ISO internal auditors for ISO: 9001: 2015 & ISO: 22000: 2005 and 45 officers were appointed as internal auditor for ISO: 14001:2015 those who are being conducting audit at every 6 months interval.

### 10 (E) Training regarding Food Safety and Standards Act: (FOSTAC TRAINING)

It is necessary to give training to supervisors, the one supervisor should be at every 25 employees as per Food Safety and Standard Act, in this regard, 84 officers from Sumul Dairy and its all units were imparted training during 15 to 18 March 2021.

### 11 NEW PROJECTS & EXPANSION ACTIVITIES:

By the Surat District Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., Sumul Dairy Surat, the activities of milk procurement and milk distribution are increasing continuously; to accelerate milk processing and to introduce new products in the market and to increase handling capacity of the plant, milk/butter milk/products, by the use of machineries with well advanced technology, the expansion work in phase manners done in different departments. Details are in short as follows.

- \* To utilize whey, which is produces as byproduct during Paneer and Sweet production, the union for Sumul Dairy Surat has placed order for fully automatic "whey" utilization project. The quality of butter milk (Chhaas) will be improved due to protein content in whey and by the utilization of whey approximately 15000 litres per day; this project will be viable in six months.
- \* Gujarat government made fire NOC compulsory to avail factory license. Union for Sumul Dairy Surat, has placed order for necessary fire fighting Fire Hydrant System to install and make functional to get fire NOC. The system will cover whole dairy plant and administration building. The fire hydrant points will be given in the different buildings of plant and automatic sprinkler system will be installed in packing material storage. By the installation of this system, there will be ease to maintain required safety.
- \* The machine for special variety of candy has been installed and made functional at Navi Pardi of Sumul Dairy. The special variety of Tilli Kulfi (Rabdi/Punjabi) in "AMUL" brand is being produced and supplying in market. Now, we could be able to supply in various varieties as per federation's demand.

### 11.1 Future projects:

- \* To supply fortified wheat flour 20MT/day to ICDS, Government of Gujarat, among the Sumul Dairy, Government of Gujarat and GCMMF tri party agreement made. The process of purchasing machinery for that purpose has been done with the help of GCMMF.
- \* To fulfillment of daily needs of milk producers, the effort is being done to establish Sumul Kisaan Bazaar. Through which, the goods of daily needs of dairy farmers to be available at reasonable price, so that arrangement to be made the vegetables and bakery products to be available. The infrastructure of chilling centers such as Nizar, Uchchhal, Bajipura and Navi Pardi will be taken in use.

### 12. EXPRESSION OF GRATEFULNESS:

Central Government and State Government have extended support for the development of our union, milk societies and milk producers. In response of that, we are very grateful of the Prime Minister, the Chief Minister, the Dy. Chief Minister and all the government officials.






